

Young Researchers in Archaeometry (YRA) 2nd Workshop

The 2nd workshop for “Young Researchers in Archaeometry” will take place at the **FU GeoCampus Lankwitz in Berlin** from **23 to 25 September 2018**. The meeting welcomes early career researchers (master, PhD, post-doc) with a focus on topics intersecting natural science and cultural studies.

Like the 1st workshop in September 2017 in Frankfurt, the 2nd workshop offers early career researchers an interdisciplinary platform for mutual exchange and networking. Talks and posters can be presented in a relaxed atmosphere. Discussion rounds, lab and workshop visits as well as a barbecue on campus provide the possibility for lively conversations and interesting insights in related areas. The workshop is organized by Katharina Kuntz, Ralf Milke and Thomas Rose and is kindly supported by the research group „Archäometrie & Denkmalpflege“ of the Deutsche Mineralogische Gesellschaft (DMG), the Freie Universität Berlin, the Berlin Graduate School of Ancient Studies (BerGSAS/BAK) the Excellence Cluster TOPOI and the ArchäometrieNetzwerk Berlin-Brandenburg (ANBB).

Interested participants are invited to propose a presentation or poster. We welcome contributions dealing with research questions in archaeometry (material analyses, dating, prospection) coming from the field of archaeology, art history, anthropology, biology, chemistry, conservation, cultural heritage, earth science, material science, medicine, physics, etc.

200 word **abstracts** can be submitted until 20 August 2018. The workshop language is English and German. Possible formats include:

- Talk: 15 minutes plus 5 minutes discussion
- Poster presentation (DIN A1 or A0, vertical format): 5 minutes

Registration is open until 3 September 2018. The **workshop fee** is 30 €. Travel funds (50 €) are available for student members of the DMG from outside Berlin / Potsdam.
